Teqball

Teqball, founded in 2014 in Hungary, is a soccer-based sport played on a specially curved table called a Teq Table. Games are played in singles or doubles with a points-based scoring format where points can be scored with any part of your body except arms or hands. Players are given a maximum of three touches before returning the ball to the opponent and control of the ball.

The Kansas City Convention Center played host to 7,000 guests for the United Soccer Coaches Convention in January 2022. Teqball was showcased at the convention with two-time Olympic champion and two-time FIFA Women's World Cup winner, Carli Lloyd, leading a demonstration of the sport. Ajay Nwosu, the CEO & President of Teqball, revealed in a presentation that the sport's goal is to be included in the 2028 Summer Olympics. Numerous professional soccer players were in attendance to lend their support—and excitement—for the launch and future of Teqball. 

Book Recommendation

Ripple: A Long Strange Search for a Killer

Local children's entertainer, Jim Cosgrove aka Mr. Stinky Feet has written a captivating summer read about the disappearance of Kansas City native, Frank McGonigle. After 26 years of research, revisions, twists, turns, dead ends, deadheads, and psychic visions, this unsolved murder mystery about a lost Grateful Dead fan is now a book. Ripple published on April 5, 2022, coinciding with the 40th anniversary year of the disappearance of Frank, who left his Kansas City home in 1982 and never returned. His large Irish-Catholic family searched nine years for him, only to learn of his murder in a gritty South Carolina fishing village. Follow along as Cosgrove shares the rippling effects of this decade-old case. With the help of a cast of salty characters, Cosgrove uncovers connections to a ruthless local crime boss and miscues from a threadbare sheriff's department. A chance meeting with a soft-hearted psychic who provided freakishly accurate details about Frank's death put Cosgrove face to face with the alleged killer.



Grilled Chipotle Chicken Salad

Ingredients

- 2lbs chicken thighs
- marinade
 - 1/4 cup olive oil
 - 2 chipotle peppers (canned) + 2 tbs adobo sauce (juice from can)
 - 4 garlic cloves
 - 1 shallot
 - 1 1/2 tbs cumin
 - 1 tbs coriander
 - 2 tsp chill powder
 - 1 tsp dried oregano
 - 2 tsp salt



Instructions:

1. Preheat grill to medium-high.
2. Place marinade ingredients in a *food processor* and process into a paste. Place the chicken and marinade in a ziplock bag and massage well to mix and coat all sides well. (Or brush all sides well with marinade and place in a container.) Marinate 20 mins or overnight
3. Grill each side of chicken 6-7 minutes, or until good grill marks appear. Lower heat and move chicken to cooler side of the grill and continue to grill until chicken is cooked through and internal temperature reaches 165F.
4. Let it rest 5-10 mins before serving and squeeze with lime. Sprinkle with optional cilantro.
